Deciding on Treatment Options is the title of a talk to be delivered by, Consultant Urologist, **Mr Khaver Qureshi** at a meeting being held on 18th January at the **City Halls, Glasgow** and is open to all prostate cancer patients, their families and their carers.

Like any cancer diagnosis, what to do next and when to do it is an important decision for the patient and his family. There needs to be discussion of his own views and attitudes with the consultant before the best treatment options are considered. Carefully considered patient contribution can only help all concerned reach the right decision.
